VIKAS BAHL, J.(ORAL)

1. Learned counsel for the respondent has submitted that the respondent has died and even prior to the death of the respondent, his son had died.
2. Learned counsel for the appellants has submitted that in view of the above, the present appeal may be disposed of as having been rendered infructuous but liberty may be granted to the appellants to revive the appeal, in case any cause of action survives.
3. In view of the above, present appeal is disposed of as having been rendered infructuous with the aforesaid liberty.
4. In view of the fact that the main appeal has been disposed of as having been rendered infructuous, the cross-objection is also disposed of but liberty is granted to the cross-objector to revive the same, in case the main appeal is restored.
