1. The petitioner has filed the instant petition under Section 482 of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.87 dated 10.09.2024 registered under Sections 406 & 498-A of Indian Penal Code, 1860 at Police Station Women Cell, District Patiala.
2. Mr. C.S. Jattana, Advocate has put in appearance on behalf of respondent No.2 and filed his power of attorney in the Court which is taken on record.
3. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that, in pursuance to the order dated 21.03.2025 passed by this Court, the petitioner has appeared before the Investigating Officer and has joined the investigation.
