1. The suit in the present case was filed by the four plaintiffs in the year 1986 against the State of Punjab and several other defendants. The suit was decreed. Against the same, only State of Punjab had filed an appeal and the said appeal was dismissed.

2. A perusal of the paper book would show that there is no interim order in favour of the appellant-State.

Learned counsel for the appellant has submitted that in view of the lapse of time, the present appeal be disposed of but liberty be granted to the appellant to revive the same in case the respondents approach the office of the concerned department or file execution with respect to the reliefs which as per the State are not admissible to them.

4. In view of the above, the present appeal is disposed of with the aforesaid liberty.
