4. During the course of hearing on 21.03.2025, following order was passed:

“2. It is, inter alia, contended by learned counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner is innocent and has been falsely implicated in this case on account of party faction. He contends that even the cross version has also been registered against the complainant party for causing injury to the petitioner. He contends that as per the allegations, the injury attributed to the petitioner is simple in nature on non vital part of the body and even the main accused as per the FIR namely Kulwant Singh @ Kanti has also been granted the concession of anticipatory bail vide order dated 14.02.2025, passed in CRM-M-378- 2025, ‘Kulwant Singh @ Kanti vs. State of Punjab’. Hence, the instant petition.

3. Notice of motion.

4. On the asking of the Court, Mr. Ankit Grewal, DAG, Punjab, present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of the State-respondent. He does not dispute the factual matrix of the case and submits that injury attributed to the petitioner is simple in nature and prays for time to file the status report/reply in the matter.

5. Adjourned to 04.04.2025.

6. Needful be done well before the date fixed with an advance copy to the counsel opposite.

7. In the meanwhile, the petitioner is hereby directed to join investigation within seven days from today and in the event of his arrest, he is ordered to be released on interim bail on his furnishing personal/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer/Investigating Officer. He shall also abide by conditions as envisaged under Section 482(2) of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita 2023 (BNSS).

8. Investigating Officer (concerned) to remain present in

Court along with relevant records on the date fixed.”

5. Keeping in view the above submissions made by learned State counsel and the fact that the petitioner had joined the investigation consequent to the order dated 21.03.2025 and 04.04.2025 passed by this Court, interim bail granted vide order dated 21.03.2025 and 04.04.2025 is hereby confirmed, subject to conditions as envisaged under Section 482 (2) of BNSS, 2023. Further the petitioner is directed to join investigation as and when required in future by way of written notice for such purpose to be served by Investigating Officer of this case upon the petitioner; he will not tamper with the evidence nor will influence the witnesses and will not leave the country without prior permission of the Court.
6. The petition stands allowed.
7. It is made clear that anything contained hereinabove shall not be construed to be an expression of opinion on the merits of the case.
