1. In the present writ petition, the petitioner is praying for issuance of a direction to the respondents to release the balance amount of medical reimbursement of Rs.1,19,770/- to the petitioner alongwith 18% interest from the date of accrual till the date of actual payment made.

2. Written statement has been filed on behalf of respondents No.1 to 4. In para No.13 of the same, as per the respondents, the claim of the petitioner for medical reimbursement of an amount of Rs.2,96,729/- was duly considered, the petitioner has been held entitled for grant of Rs.1,76,959/- taking into consideration the reimbursement policy of the State.

3. Learned state counsel submits that as per the reimbursement policy framed by the State of Punjab, the amount of medical reimbursement of Rs.1,76,959/- has already been released to the petitioner.

4. Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner on instructions from the petitioner submits that although the respondents have stated in the written statement that the sanctioned amount has already been released to the petitioner but no calculation/details has been given in regard

to the sanctioned amount to Rs.1,76,959/-. He submits that the present writ petition may be disposed of with liberty to petitioner to file a representation to the respondents requesting therein for giving calculation/details as to on what basis, the respondents have sanctioned an amount of Rs.1,76,959/-.

5. In view of the above, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 that in case, the petitioner submits such representation claiming details of calculation/details in regard to release of medical reimbursement, in that case, the same may be considered and decided by respondent No.2 within a period of 02 months.
