1. In the present writ petition, the petitioners are praying for direction to respondents to grant the benefit of two additional increments to the petitioners. Reliance has been placed upon the judgment of Co-ordinate Bench of this Court in **CWP No.20712 of 2006 titled as “Jaswinder Singh and others Vs. The Registrar, Cooperative Societies, Punjab and others** and **CWP No.14244 of 2013 titled “Bhupinder Kumar and others Vs. State of Punjab and others decided on 04.01.2024.**

2. Learned counsel for the petitioners, on instructions from the petitioners, submits that at this stage, petitioners will be satisfied if a direction be given to respondent Nos.3 and 4 to decide the legal notice dated 14.11.2024 (Annexure P-13), by passing an appropriate speaking order in a time bound manner.



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3. In view of the above and without commenting upon the merits of the case, this petition is hereby disposed of with a direction to the respondents No.3 and 4 to consider and decide the legal notice dated 14.11.2024 (Annexure P-13), which is pending before the authorities concerned within a period of 03 months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order by passing an appropriate speaking order in accordance with law. In event, the petitioners are held entitled for grant of relief as claimed in the writ petition, the same be also released to them within a period of two months thereafter.

4. Pending applications, if any, also stand disposed of accordingly.
