1. The petitioner has filed the present petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India read with Section 528 of BNSS, 2023, for issuance of directions to the respondents to provide protection of life and liberty to the petitioner.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that *de hors* the averments made in the present petition, the petitioner would be satisfied if the official respondents are directed to decide his representation dated 19.03.2025 (Annexure P-9).
3. Notice of motion to the official respondents only.
4. Mr. Tarun Aggarwal, Sr. DAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the State.
5. Without entering upon an exercise to evaluate the evidentiary value of the documents placed on the file, I dispose of the petition with a direction to respondent no.2-Senior Superintendent of Police, Bathinda to decide representation dated 19.03.2025 (Annexure P-9) and grant protection of life and liberty to the petitioner, if any threat to his life and liberty is perceived.
6. It is clarified that this order shall not be taken to grant immunity to the petitioner from legal action for violation of law, if any, committed by him.
