HARSIMRAN SINGH SETHI, J. (Oral)

1. After arguing for some time, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the claim of the petitioner for the grant of wages for the period 01.10.1994 to 28.02.1995 was declined by the Labour Court on the ground that no such application is maintainable under Section 33-C(2) of the Industrial Disputes Act, 1947 (for short "1947 Act").

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the present petition may kindly be disposed of as having been not pressed any further but liberty be given to the petitioner to avail appropriate remedy either under the 1947 Act or under the Payment of Wages Act, 1936, to redress his grievance.

3. Ordered accordingly.

4. Pending application, if any, also stands disposed of.
