1. Prayer made in the present petition is for directing the respondents to implement the order dated 04.07.2024, Annexure P-7, whereby pay of the petitioner has been refixed w.e.f. 1.1.2018.

2. Learned counsel would contend that regarding the claim raised in the present petition, legal notice dated 04.11.2024, request letter dated 03.02.2025 and reminder dated 27.02.2025, Annexures P-8 to P-10, respectively, have been submitted, which have yet not evoked any response. He, on instructions, prays that a direction may be given to the respondents to decide the same in a time bound manner, to which learned State counsel has no objection.

3. In view of the above and without commenting upon the merits of the case, this petition is hereby disposed of with a direction to the respondents to decide the legal notice dated 04.11.2024, request letter

dated 03.02.2025 and reminder dated 27.02.2025, within a period of 4 months, which this Court has no reason to believe the authorities would not address in a just, fair and reasonable manner. Upon doing so, after notice and hearing offered to him and if found entitled, grant the benefit forthwith. Needless to say, if the orders are adverse to his interest, the same shall contain reasons and the petitioner shall be free to seek legal redress thereupon.
