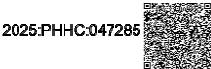

The petition has been filed, *inter alia*, seeking a writ of *certiorari* quashing the order dated 07.02.2025, Annexure P-7, whereby the petitioner's representation dated 17.07.2024, against cancellation of his candidature for the post of Draughtsman Mechanical Instructor, category no.47, in response to advertisement 12/2019, has been rejected on the ground that he did not upload ITI certificate along with application form for the post dated 20.09.2019. Accordingly, he could not have been considered ineligible for the post.

2. It is not disputed that a valid ITI certificate is one of the essential qualifications for the post. Learned counsel for the petitioner has contended that the said certificate could not be uploaded due to technical error at the time of filling up the application form. The plea of technical error in uploading the certificate of essential qualification cannot be raised at this stage, *viz.* after more than five years of uploading the application form.



3. In view thereof, there is no ground to entertain the petition and it stands dismissed *in limine*.
