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**NAMIT KUMAR, J. (ORAL)**

1. The petitioner has filed the instant revision petition challenging the order dated 11.02.2025 passed by learned Additional Sessions Judge, Fast Track Special Court, Gurdaspur, whereby an application filed by the petitioner under Section 187(2) of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 seeking default bail in case FIR No.18 dated 31.05.2015 registered under Sections 363, 366, 376(G) & 34 of Indian Penal Code, 1860, Section 4 of Protection of Children from Sexual Offence Act, 2012 and Section 3(XI) of Scheduled Caste and Scheduled Tribes (Prevention of Atrocities) Act, 1989 at Police Station Kotli Surat Malahi, has been dismissed.
2. Learned State counsel, on instructions from SI Nishan Singh, submits that since the petitioner has been acquitted by the Trial Court, therefore, the instant petition has been rendered infructuous.
