SURYA PARTAP SINGH, J. (Oral):

1. This is a petition for anticipatory bail filed under Section 482 of Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023 (hereinafter referred to as 'BNS') in case arising out of FIR No.24 dated 27.02.2025 under Sections 212, 217, 316(2), 318(4), 61(2) of BNS, Police Station Division No.1, District Pathankot.

2. Vide order dated 24.03.2025, the petitioner was admitted to interim anticipatory bail, subject to the condition of furnishing bail/surety bonds to the satisfaction of Investigating/Arresting Officer. The petitioner was also directed to cooperate with the Investigating/Arresting Officer.

3. On the instructions of ASI Darbari Lal, who is present in Court, learned State Counsel has stated that the petitioner has joined the investigation. He has further stated that the presence of petitioner is not required for the investigation of the present case.



4. Keeping in view the aforesaid facts, the present petition is hereby allowed and the order dated 24.03.2025 granting interim bail to the petitioner is hereby made absolute.
