H.S. GREWALJ.

1. The petitioners in the present petition filed under Section 528 of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 are seeking to quash the impugned FIR No. 152 dated 17.06.2015, registered under Sections 323 325, 341 and 506 read with Section 34 of the Indian Penal Code, at Police Station Kapurthala City, District Kapurthala (Annexure P-1) and all the subsequent proceedings arising therefrom on account of compromise dated 08.03.2025 (Annexure P-3), arrived at between the parties.

2. A Coordinate Bench of this Court vide order dated 27.03.2025 had directed the parties to appear before the trial Court to get their statements recorded and the learned Magistrate was directed to send its report qua the genuineness of the compromise.

3. Pursuant to the aforesaid order, parties have appeared before the learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Kapurthala and got their statements recorded.

On the basis of the statements so recorded, learned Magistrate has submitted copy of report dated 19.04.2025 to the effect that the compromise has been effected between the parties voluntarily and without any coercion or undue influence.

4. Learned State counsel as well as counsel for respondent No.2 have not disputed the factum of compromise between the parties.

5. In view of the above, no useful purpose would be served to continue with the proceedings before the trial Court in the instant FIR.

6. Following the principles laid down by the Full Bench judgment of this Court in **Kulwinder Singh and others Versus State of Punjab and another 2007 (3) RCR (Criminal) 1052** and approved by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in **Gian Singh Versus State of Punjab and others (2012) 10 SCC 303**, this petition is allowed and FIR No. 152 dated 17.06.2015, registered under Sections 323, 325, 341 and 506 read with Section 34 of the Indian Penal Code, at Police Station Kapurthala City, District Kapurthala (Annexure P-1) and all the subsequent proceedings arising therefrom on account of compromise dated 08.03.2025 (Annexure P-3), are quashed qua the petitioners.
