The instant Writ Petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India *inter alia* seeking issuance of a writ in the nature of Mandamus for directing respondents No.3 to 5 to take action against respondents No.6 and 7 for their acts of commission and omission.

2. On advance service of copy of petition, Mr. Nirmaljit Singh Diwana, Sr. DAG, Punjab, appears on behalf of respondent-State.

3. Learned State counsel, on instructions from Mr. Yudhvir Singh, District Development and Panchayat Officer, Pathankot, submits that the complaints submitted against respondents No.6 and 7 are being inquired into and presently the inquiry is pending before the Additional Deputy Commissioner (Development), Pathankot.

4. Keeping in view the aforesaid stand taken by learned State

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counsel, no further orders are required to be passed in the instant writ petition, therefore the same stands disposed of.

5. However, it goes without saying that the inquiry which is stated to be pending before the Additional Deputy Commissioner (Development), Pathankot shall be taken to its logical end and final order be passed within a period of three months from today.
