KULDEEP TIWARI, J.(Oral)

1. Through the instant petition, prayer is made for passing a direction upon the investigating agency concerned to conduct investigation in FIR bearing No.135, dated 05.05.2020, registered under Sections 341, 452, 324, 323, 148 and 149 of the IPC, at Police Station Sadar, Fazilka (Annexure P-4), in a fair and unbiased manner as well as to handover the investigation to some senior officer by forming a Special Investigating Team (SIT).
2. The second prayer is regarding taking action against main

accused Amandeep Kumar alias Amandeep Skoda alias Amandeep Kamboj, on whose behest the present petitioner has been falsely implicated.

3. Finally, the third prayer is made for issuance of directions to conclude the investigation in all the criminal cases, in which the present petitioner is arrayed as an accused, which comes out to be 38 cases.

4. During the course of arguments, it transpires that all the aforementioned prayers, which have been made before this Court, have become rendered infructuous, for the reason that the investigation in the instant FIR has already been conducted, and the petitioner has been found innocent by the investigating agency, and thereupon, a cancellation report has been prepared, and the same has been filed before the learned *Illaq*a Magistrate concerned.

5. So far as second prayer, regarding taking action against aforesaid Amandeep Kumar is concerned, he has already been arrested in the instant FIR, and a final report against Amandeep Kumar has already been filed before the learned *Illaq*a Magistrate concerned.

6. Learned State counsel, on instructions imparted to him by the police official concerned, informs this Court that in fact Amandeep Kumar, has been found accused in 48 other criminal cases, and in all those cases investigation has been concluded, and final report(s) has been filed.

7. In view of all the above recorded supervening events, the instant petition is ordered to be **disposed of**, as having been rendered infructuous.

8. All pending application(s), if any, also stand **disposed** of accordingly.
