The grievance raised by the petitioner is that she has been offered appointment to the post of TGT Sanskrit pursuant to advertisement 02/2023, dated 21.02.2023, in Mewat cadre as a BCA category candidate, ignoring her merit and preference for Rest of Haryana cadre, which is arbitrary and illegal.

2. Pursuant to the order dated 24.03.2025 passed by this Court, the petitioner's result as well as scrutiny form have been produced, a perusal whereof shows that she has secured more marks than the last selected candidate in BCA category, and has opted for Rest of Haryana cadre as first preference. Accordingly, it appears that on account of some mistake on the respondents' part the petitioner has been allocated Mewat cadre instead of Rest of Haryana, which she is entitled to as per the preference given, as also on merit.

3. Learned State counsel does not dispute that the petitioner herein is similarly placed as petitioners in CWP-19489-2024 titled *Krishan Kumar and another v. State of Haryana and others*, decided on 04.09.2024.



4. In view thereof, the petition stands disposed of in terms of *Krishan Kumar* case *ibid*, by directing the Commission to correct the error/mistake in the merit list, and recommend the petitioner for appointment as TGT Sanskrit in Rest of Haryana cadre under BCA category as per merit. The second respondent shall, thereupon, offer appointment to the petitioner, subject to her fulfilling the requisite conditions, from the date other selected candidates pursuant to the selection in question have been appointed. The directions shall be carried out by the respondents within a period of four weeks of receiving a certified copy of the order.
