1. After arguing for some time, learned counsel for the petitioners

respondent No.3 raising a grievance that at the time when the petitioners retired, they were senior to respondent No.5 in the Cadre of Station Fire Officer hence, they are entitled for the step up of their pay in comparison to respondent No.5 by giving due and valid reasons and the respondent No.3 be directed to pass an appropriate speaking order on the said representation.

2. Learned counsel for the respondent No.3 submits that in case any such grievance is being raised by the petitioner, the same will be given due consideration by the respondent No.3 within a period of **six weeks** from the date of the receipt of certified copy of this order by passing an appropriate speaking order. Learned counsel for respondent No.3 further submits that in case, it is found feasible to grant the relief to the petitioners, the same will be granted, otherwise due reasons will be mentioned for not accepting the claim of the petitioners in the speaking order to be passed and the said order will be duly conveyed to the petitioners.

5. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that keeping in view the statement of learned counsel for respondent No.3, the present petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further.
