This petition has been filed under Section 482 of BNSS, 2023 for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.27 dated 25.2.2025, U/s 318(4), 336(3), 340 (2), 61(2) of BNS, 2023 (old Section 420, 468, 120-B of IPC), U/s: 24 of Immigration Act, P.S. East Sector 26, Distt. Chandigarh.

In compliance to previous order dated 28.03.2025, today learned counsel for the petitioner has handed over a cheque bearing No. 060659, in the name of Amardeep Kaur, amounting to Rs. 4,00,000/- to learned counsel for the complainant. A copy of the same is taken on record as Document 'A'.

A balance of Rs. 3.80 lakhs has been undertaken by the counsel for the petitioner to be repaid in equal monthly installments which shall be of Rs. 1 lakh each. The said installments shall be paid by 7th of every month. In this way, the last installment will be in the month of August i.e. of Rs. 80,000/- after three installments of Rs. 1 lakh each to be paid in the month of May, June and July.

In case there is any default, the respondent-complainant would be at liberty to move an application for cancellation of anticipatory bail.

Learned State counsel on instructions from Investigating Officer submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation on 02.04.2025 and the custodial interrogation of the petitioner is not required.

In view of the above, the order dated 28.03.2025 is made absolute.

Accordingly, the present petition is disposed of.
