Mr. Samay Sandhawalia, Advocate has put in appearance on behalf of the respondent and has filed his power of attorney, which is taken on record.

2. At the outset, he submits that the order dated 26.12.2024 was withdrawn on 28.12.2024 itself.
3. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that despite stay of the operation of the impugned order dated 30.09.2024, the petitioner is not being permitted to teach as a PGT teacher.
4. To this, learned counsel for the respondent submits that the stay was obtained by concealing certain facts and that the respondent is in the process of moving an application for vacation of stay.
5. That being so, no further orders are required to be passed by this Court at this stage and the rule is accordingly discharged.
6. The contempt petition is disposed of.
