1. The petitioners through instant petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India are seeking setting aside of order dated 03.01.2001 whereby their representation was rejected. They are further seeking directions to respondent to promote them as Assistant Sub Inspector (**ASI**) w.e.f. 20.05.1986.
2. The petitioners joined service in 1977. There is no representation of the petitioners and learned State counsel is unaware of their status. The petitioners must have retired during the pendency of instant petition.
3. It appears that with the efflux of time, petitioners have lost their interest to pursue the instant petition.
4. **Dismissed** with liberty to the petitioners to move an appropriate application within six months from today, if cause survives.
5. Pending application(s), if any, shall also stand disposed of.
