N.S. SHEKHAWAT, J.

1. The present petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India with a prayer to issue directions to the officials respondents No.1 to 7 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners as well as not to demolish the house of the petitioners in pursuance of the letter issued by respondents No.6 to respondent No.7. A further prayer has been made to direct respondents No.1 to 7 to abide by the directions issued by Hon'ble the Supreme Court of India in Writ Petition(Civil) No.295 of 2022 (Annexure P-5).

2. On an advance notice, Mr. Sartaj Singh Gill, Sr. DAG, Punjab has put in appearance on behalf of the respondents and submitted that notices have been issued to the petitioners. However, the official respondents shall strictly abide by the directions issued by Hon'ble the Supreme Court of India in Writ Petition(Civil) No.295 of 2022 as well as the procedure established by law.

3. In view of the statement made by learned State counsel, learned counsel for the petitioners does not intend to press the present petition at this stage.

4. Dismissed as not pressed, at this stage.
