1. Present petition has been filed under Section 483 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 (BNSS), seeking regular bail in FIR No.13 dated 21.02.2021, registered under Section 302 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860, at Police Station Amant Khan, District Tarn Taran.

2. Allegation against the petitioner is that he committed murder of his own wife.

3. After addressing arguments for some time, learned counsel for the petitioner seeks permission to withdraw the present petition at this stage.

4. Accordingly, petition is dismissed as withdrawn at this stage.



5.           However, taking into consideration the fact that the petitioner has been in custody for the last 4 years and 5 months, and that out of a total of 18 prosecution witnesses, only 7 have been examined till date, the learned Trial Court is directed to expedite the trial proceedings and conclude the same within a period of six months from today, positively.
