JAGMOHAN BANSAL, J. (ORAL)

1. The petitioner through instant petition under Articles 226 & 227 of the Constitution of India is seeking direction to respondents to issue him Constabulary number.
2. The petitioner claims that he was at Serial No. 1 in the waiting list and despite availability of vacancy, he was not issued appointment letter.
3. Vakalatnama filed by Mr. Gurcharan Dass, Advocate on behalf of the petitioner is taken on record. Registry is directed to tag the same at appropriate place.
4. Mr. Raman Sharma, Addl. A.G.Haryana submits that petitioner belongs to General Category and there was no vacant post in the said category, thus, he was not issued appointment letter.



5. In the wake of statement of learned State counsel and further considering the fact that a period of 25 years from the date of conclusion of recruitment process has passed away, the cause does not survive.
6. Dismissed with liberty to petitioner to move an appropriate application within three months from today, if cause survives.
