1. After arguing for some time, learned counsel for the petitioner-grandson submits that the petitioner-grandson, who is present in Court has instructed him that he intends to take care of his grandmother i.e respondent No.2 as required and an amount of Rs.10,000/- per month as directed by the authorities concerned will be given to the respondent No.2-grandmother along with arrears from the date the said amount was directed to be paid by the authorities concerned.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner-grandson further submits that whatever amount has already been paid by the petitioner-grandson will be adjusted and the remaining amount will be deposited in the bank



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account of the respondent No.2-grandmother within a period of two months from today. Learned counsel for the petitioner-grandson submits that by the 7th of every month, an amount of Rs.10,000/- will be deposited in the bank account of the respondent No.2-grandmother.

3. Learned counsel for the respondent No.2-grandmother submits that the respondent No.2-grandmother is already living in Old Age Home where she is comfortable and will continue residing there and the petitioner-grandson be directed to comply with the undertaking and the clothes of the respondent No.2-grandmother, which are lying in the house be sent to her by the petitioner-grandson.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that not only the old clothes but the new clothes will be given to the respondent No.2-grandmother so as to live a dignified life even if, she is living in Old Age Home.

5. Keeping in view the undertaking given by the petitioner, as recorded hereinbefore, the present petition is disposed of in above terms. In case of failure to abide by undertaking, learned counsel for respondent No.2 is free to file application.

6. Civil miscellaneous application pending, if any, is also disposed of.
