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**VIKRAM AGGARWAL, J (ORAL)**

1. This is a petition preferred under Section 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971 alleging violation of order dated 06.09.2024 (Annexure P-1) passed by a Division Bench of this Court in ***CWP No.8322 of 2024***.

2. At the outset, learned counsel representing the State of Haryana submits that the order dated 06.09.2024 had been passed in terms of the law laid down in ***CWP No.17310 of 2015*** titled as '***Shamsher Singh Vs. State of Haryana and Others***' vide order dated 19.07.2024. He further submits that the said judgment was assailed before the Supreme Court of India and the same has been stayed vide order dated 20.01.2025 passed in ***SLP (Civil) Diary No(s).50360 of 2024***.

3. That being so, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he may be permitted to withdraw the contempt petition, at this stage to await the decision of the Supreme Court of India.

4. In view of the statement given by learned counsel for the petitioner, the contempt petition is dismissed as having been withdrawn.
