1. The petitioners have filed the present petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India read with Section 528 of BNSS, 2023, for issuance of directions to respondents No.2 & 3 for protection of life and liberty of the petitioners and not to interfere in their peaceful life at the behest of respondent no.4 and his relatives.

2. Pursuant to the order dated 25.03.2025 passed by this Court, both the petitioners are present in the Court today and this Court has interacted with both of them. Petitioner no.2 admits herself to be the age of less than 18 years and states that she is in live-in relationship with petitioner no.1 and also residing with him with her own free will.

3. On the other hand, respondent no.4, who is also present in the Court, states that the allegations levelled by the petitioners regarding threat to their life and liberty at his behest are totally baseless and he has no objection to their relationship and assures the Court that he will not take any such action which would prejudice life and liberty of the petitioners in any manner.

4. This Court has given option to petitioner no.2 to stay in Nari Niketan, Chandigarh till she attains the age of majority, but she flatly disagreed to this and rather resists that she will go only with petitioner no.1 as she apprehends no danger from him and his family members.

5. Faced with this situation, learned counsel for the petitioners prays for withdrawal of the present petition in view of the assurance given by respondent no.4.

6. Allowed to do so.

7. Dismissed as withdrawn accordingly.
