1. The petitioner herein is defendant No. 3 in a pending plaintiff's suit for grant of decree of declaration to the effect that the plaintiff and *proforma* defendants are owners in possession of the agricultural land.

2. In substance, the parties to the litigation are members of the same family. Defendant No.1-Sh. Ram Swaroop has a wife and six children (two sons and four daughters). The suit was filed by one son and two daughters. Originally, defendants No. 1 to 5 filed a joint written statement. Subsequently, he filed application before the trial Court for permission to file a separate written statement on the ground that defendants No. 3 and 4 have cheated him and obtained his signatures. The plaintiff's counsel made 'no objection'. Ultimately, the Court, in the peculiar facts of the case, permitted defendants No. 1 to 5 to file a separate written statement. It is well known that additional pleadings can be permitted to be filed in the peculiar facts of the case.



- 3. Keeping in view the aforesaid facts, no ground to interfere is made out.
- 4. Hence, the revision petition is dismissed.
- 5. All the pending miscellaneous applications, if any, are also disposed of.
