Prayer in the instant petition filed under Section 528 of BNSS, 2023 is for issuance of direction to the official respondents to get the investigation of case FIR No.10 dated 01.03.2025, under Sections 140(3) of BNS, registered at Police Station Rawalpindi, District Kapurthala by constituting SIT of Senior Police Officers.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has contended that the petitioner is a social worker having good reputation in the society and has been falsely implicated in the present case. Respondent No.7 (brother of the complainant), who has high profile links with the drug paddlers in the State of Punjab, has falsely implicated the petitioner in the present case, in connivance with the police officials. The petitioner has nothing to do with the offence in question. Despite moving several representations to the higher authorities, no action has been taken to ensure fair and impartial inquiry.

After perusing the file, it appears that instead of availing alternative efficacious remedy, the petitioner has directly approached this Court by way of this present petition.

In view of the above, the efficacious alternative remedy is available to the petitioner, which has not been exhausted and as such, the present petition is not maintainable and is disposed of accordingly.
