The prayer in the present petition under Section 482 of Cr.P.C. is for quashing of the order dated 03.02.2023 (Annexure P-3) passed by the Addl. Sessions Judge, Jalandhar whereby the warrants of arrest has been issued and bail bonds and surety bonds of the petitioner have been forfeited to the State in case FIR No.130 dated 07.08.2019 registered under Sections 326, 324, 323, 148, 149 IPC, 1860 and (Sections 307, 325 IPC added later on) at Police Station Adampur, District Jalandhar.

None has put in appearance on behalf of the petitioner.

On 21.04.2023, the following order was passed:-

“Petitioner (Manjinder Singh @ Laddi) has filed the present petition under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for setting aside impugned order dated 03.02.2023 (Annexure P-3) passed by the Court of Additional Sessions Judge, Jalandhar, Punjab, whereby bail of the petitioner was cancelled, his bail bonds and surety bonds were forfeited to

the State and non-bailable warrants of arrest were issued against the petitioner.

Notice of motion.

At the asking of Court, Mr. Subhash Godara, Additional Advocate General, Punjab, who is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent/State. He prays for an accommodation to seek instructions and assist the Court in this matter.

At his request, adjourned to 28.05.2023.”

The learned State counsel on instructions submits that the petitioner is in custody from 13.12.2024 in FIR No.233 dated 27.10.2024 P.S. Balongi, SAS Nagar, Mohali.

In view of the above, the present petition is disposed of as having been rendered infructuous.
