**********VIKAS BAHL, J. (ORAL)**

1. Present contempt petition has been filed under Section 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, read with Article 215 of the Constitution of India for violating the order dated 27.01.2025 (Annexure P-1).

2. Learned counsel appearing for the respondent has submitted that in compliance to the judgment passed by the Co-ordinate Bench of this Court dated 27.01.2025, the Haryana Agro Industries Corporation Limited had sanctioned the release of the payment of Rs.31,01,000/- vide order dated 31.03.2025 and a copy of which has been handed over to the Court is taken on record and has been marked as "Mark A". A copy of the said order dated 31.03.2025 has been handed over the learned counsel for



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the petitioner as well.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that although the sanction has been granted but the release of the amount so sanctioned be made in a time bound manner. It is further submitted that the respondent be also directed to pay interest on the amount paid on account of the delay. It is pointed out that the petitioner is also raising a claim on the basis of 7th Pay Commission and on the said aspect, the petitioner be permitted to file a representation before the concerned quarter and a time bound direction be given. In the said regard, reliance has been placed upon an order dated 19.03.2025 passed in COCP No.1369 of 2025 by the Co-ordinate Bench of this Court under the similar circumstances.

4. Learned counsel for the respondent has fairly submitted that the amount sanctioned alongwith interest would be released within a period of two weeks from today. It is further submitted that in case any representation is made by the petitioner with respect to the claim on the basis of 7th Pay Commission, then, the same would be decided within a period of six weeks from the date of receipt of the said representation.

5. Keeping in view the above-said facts and circumstance, the present contempt petition is disposed of with the following directions: -

- (i) As undertaken before this Court, the competent authority of the Haryana Agro Industries Corporation Limited would release the amount sanctioned alongwith interest within a period of two weeks from today.

(ii) It would be open to the petitioner to move a representation with respect to the claim on the basis of 7th Pay Commission before the Competent Officer of the Haryana Agro Industries Corporation Limited and in case any such representation is made, the Competent Officer of the Haryana Agro Industries Corporation Limited would consider and decide the same within a period of six weeks from the date of receipt of the representation and would convey the order to the petitioner.
