The prayer in this petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India is for the issuance of a roving writ in the nature of Habeas Corpus directing the respondents to produce and release the detainees as mentioned in the headnote of the petition along with a prayer for the appointment of a Warrant Officer.

Though there are allegations and counter allegations of the police officials having been illegally detained or not, the parties are *ad idem* that currently none of them are in confinement.
