1. In this writ petition the impugned order dated January 30, 2025 (Annexure P-6) passed by the District Magistrate, Yamuna Nagar is under challenge.
2. Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner submits that under Rule 12(2)(e) of the Arms Rules, 2016, the authorities could have granted licence to the petitioner for any legitimate or genuine reason. The petitioner wanted to work as a security guard. However, without assigning any reason, the authorities have rejected the application of the petitioner.
3. This Court has heard the learned counsel for the petitioner and perused the material on record.
4. The petitioner has not availed of the alternative, efficacious, statutory remedy of appeal as provided under Section 18 of the Arms Act, 1959. Therefore, the present writ petition being CWP-8607-2025 is **dismissed.**

5. However, the petitioner is granted the liberty to approach the appropriate authority to avail of the statutory remedy.
6. Connected applications, if any, are also accordingly disposed of.
