1. On 25.03.2025, the following order was passed: -

“1. The petitioner through instant petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India is seeking setting aside of summary of allegations dated 06.09.2024 (Annexure P-2), charge sheet dated 17.09.2024 (Annexure P-3) and show cause notice dated 18.03.2025 (Annexure P-6) vide which punishment of dismissal from service has been proposed to him.

2. Mr. Manish Soni, Advocate submits that the petitioner vide order dated 28.02.2025 (Annexure P-8) passed by Inspector General of Police, South Range, Rewari was transferred from District Palwal to District Nuh. Despite the said order, Superintendent of Police, Palwal has issued him show cause notice proposing punishment of dismissal from service. The Superintendent of Police, Palwal, after transfer of the petitioner, has no jurisdiction to issue him notice.

3. Ms. Rajni Gupta, Additional Advocate General, Haryana, who on advance notice is present in Court, seeks time to get instructions.

4. Adjourned to 27.03.2025.”



2. Mr. Raman Sharma, Additional Advocate General, Haryana submits that transfer order was passed by Inspector General of Police while adjudicating appeal of the petitioner. The entire material was not before the Appellate Authority transfer order came to be passed. The matter with respect to petitioner’s transfer needs to be reconsidered because it is contrary to Government Instructions.

3. On being confronted with Rule 14.15 of Punjab Police Rules, 1934 (as applicable to State of Haryana), he concedes that no criminal proceedings are instituted against the petitioner, thus, he can be transferred. He submits that impugned show cause notice would not be finally adjudicated till the final decision with respect to petitioner’s transfer.

4. In the wake of statement of learned State counsel and with the consent of petitioner, the petition stands disposed of.
