1. Prayer in this application is for bringing on record the legal representative of petitioner-Sham Lal (deceased) with a permission to pursue the present petition by Sh. Gaganjot Singh s/o Sh. Kashmir Singh, r/o Village Patarsi Kalan, PO Rajindergarh, Tehsil and District Fatehgarh Sahib being legal representative.

2. Notice of the application was issued on 10.07.2019, but till date no reply has been filed. However, a joint affidavit dated 21.06.2019 on behalf of legal representatives of applicant-petitioner mentioned in para 2 of the present application, namely, Raj Rani, Arpan Gupta and Neetu Goyal (2(1 to 3 respectively) stating therein that they have no objection in case the main writ petition is pursued by Sh. Gaganjot Singh as a consequence of the

Will and have no objection in case the amount, if any, awarded and released in favour of Gaganjot Singh in respect of the land in question.

3. Having heard learned counsel for the parties and gone through the contents of the application as well as joint affidavit dated 21.06.2019, prayer made herein is allowed and Sh. Gaganjot Singh s/o Sh. Kashmir Singh, r/o Village Patarsi Kalan, PO Rajindergarh, Tehsil and District Fatehgarh Sahib is ordered to pursue the present writ petition being legal representative of the deceased-petitioner.

4. Amended memo of parties is taken on record.

5. Application stands disposed of.

Main case

1. By way of present petition, prayer has been made for issuance of direction to respondent No.1 to release the entire amount of compensation/solatium @ 30% in view of the award dated 16.11.2012 as well as interest thereon to the petitioner on account of acquisition of the land.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the benefits due towards the petitioner already stands released in his favour.

3. In view thereof, no cause survives in the present petition, as such, the same is disposed of.

4. Pending application, if any, also stands disposed of.
