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4. Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Ranbir, intimates the Court that the petitioner has joined investigation and is neither required for further investigation nor for any custodial interrogation.

5. During the course of hearing on 26.03.2025, following order was passed:

“ 2. It is, inter alia, contended by learned counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner having no concern with the allegations levelled in the FIR and also having no criminal antecedents has been falsely implicated in this case on the basis of alleged disclosure statement made by the co-accused, namely Gurnam Singh, from whom recovery of 5.48 grams of heroin was allegedly effected. He contends that the petitioner has no concern with the co-accused (supra) nor with the recovery effected from him. Hence, the instant petition.

3. Notice of motion.

4. On the asking of the Court, Mr. Arun Kumar Gujjar, AAG, Haryana, present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of the Staterespondent and does not dispute the fact that the petitioner is not having any criminal antecedents and the petitioner has been nominated on the basis of the disclosure statement made by the co-accused (supra) He prays for time to file the status report/reply in the matter.

5. Adjourned to 21.04.2025.

6. Needful be done well before the date fixed with an advance copy to the counsel opposite.

7. In the meanwhile, the petitioner is hereby directed to join investigation within seven days from today and in the event of his arrest, he is ordered to be released on interim bail on his furnishing personal/surety bonds to the satisfaction of

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the Arresting Officer/Investigating Officer. He shall also abide by conditions as envisaged under Section 482(2) of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita 2023 (BNSS).

8. Investigating Officer (concerned) to remain present in Court along with relevant records on the date fixed.”

6. Keeping in view the above submissions made by learned State counsel and the fact that the petitioner had joined the investigation consequent to the order dated 26.03.2025 passed by this Court, interim bail granted vide order dated 26.03.2025 is hereby confirmed, subject to conditions as envisaged under Section 482 (2) of BNSS, 2023. Further the petitioner is directed to join investigation as and when required in future by way of written notice for such purpose to be served by Investigating Officer of this case upon the petitioner; he will not tamper with the evidence nor will influence the witnesses and will not leave the country without prior permission of the Court.

7. The petition stands allowed.

8. It is made clear that anything contained hereinabove shall not be construed to be an expression of opinion on the merits of the case.
