KARAMJIT SINGH, J. (ORAL)

1. Counsel for the petitioner inter alia submits that respondent No.5 is husband of the petitioner while respondents No.6 and 7 are brother and sister in law of the petitioner, all of whom committed fraud against the petitioner and in this regard, petitioner has lodged complaint dated 29.01.2025 Annexure P-1 with the police authorities but till date no action has been taken by the police against the culprits on the basis of complaint Annexure P-1. It is further submitted that petitioner will be satisfied if necessary direction is given to the police authorities to decide the complaint Annexure P-1 submitted by the petitioner in accordance with law in a time bound manner.

3. Mr. J.S. Dhaliwal, AAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the State who on instructions from SI Harkirat Singh submits that matter was inquired into by the concerned police officials and it has been



recommended that the complaint be filed. The said recommendation is also approved by respondent No.3-Commissioner of Police, Amritsar but till date, no speaking order has been passed on the basis of aforesaid recommendation/approval.

4. In view of above and without going into the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of and the competent authority concerned is hereby directed to take final decision by way of speaking order with regard to complaint Annexure P-1 dated 29.01.2025 submitted by the petitioner, in accordance with law within a period of 20 days from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.
