In the present petition, the grievance being raised by the petitioner is that she is entitled for the grant of benefit of regularization of her service keeping in view the judgment of the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in **Civil Appeal No.14831-2024 titled as, Jaggo vs. Union of India & others, decided on 20.12.2024.**

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the grievance which has been raised in the present petition, has already been raised by the petitioner in the representation dated 01.02.2025 (Annexure P/5), which is pending consideration with the respondents and the petitioner will be satisfied in case, a time bound direction is issued to respondent No.3 to decide the same in a time bound manner.

5. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that keeping in view the statement made by learned counsel for respondents No.2 and 3, present petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further.
