This is Criminal Writ Petition Under Article 226/227 of the constitution of India Praying for issuance of writ in the nature of Mandamus directing the respondent No. 1, 2, 3 & 4 not to interfere in the personal lives and personal liberty of the petitioners and further directing the respondents no. 1, 2 & 3 not allow/let respondents no. 4 or anybody else to interfere with the liberty and lives of the petitioners in any manner and for issuance of any other appropriate order or direction to which this Hon'ble Court may deem fit and proper in the facts and circumstances of the case as made out hereunder.

The representation has been made by the petitioners on 24.03.2025 (Annexure P-5) as is evident from the postal receipt attached with the representation.

According to the SOP framed by the Home Department, Government of Punjab, the grievance is to be addressed if any so raised within a period of three days from the date of its receipt.

However, in the instant case apparently representation has not been decided despite lapse of ten days by now.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Jaspal Singh Guru, AAG Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of respondent/State and undertakes that the necessary steps will be taken and representation in question will be decided after providing an opportunity of hearing to the petitioners as well as private respondents within a period of three days from today.

In the light of above, learned counsel for the petitioner prays for withdrawal of the present petition.

Prayer is accepted.

Dismissed as withdrawn.
