1. The learned State counsel assures this Court that till a decision is taken on the resolution of the Gram Panchayat concerned, whereby the subject lands have been permitted to be re-alienated to the present petitioner, thereupto the impugned letter (Annexure P-9) shall remain stayed.
2. Consequently, the learned counsel for the petitioner prays prays for, and, is permitted to withdraw the instant petition.
3. However, the Approving Authority concerned, seized with the resolution of the Gram Panchayat concerned, is directed to within a period of two months from today take a lawful decision on the said resolution, but after hearing the present petitioner. In case a decision adversarial to the present petitioner is made, thereupon it is open to the present petitioner to avail all permissible remedies as per law.
4. Disposed of accordingly.
