1. This is a petition filed under Section 438 of Cr.P.C for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No. 66 dated 06.02.2025 under Sections 406, 420 of IPC (Section 467, 468, 471 & 120-B of IPC added later on) registered at Police Station Nissing, District Karnal, Haryana.
2. This Court, vide order dated 20.05.2025, had directed the petitioner to appear before the SHO/Investigating Officer and join investigation and in the event of his arrest, he was ordered to be released on ad-interim bail to the satisfaction of the SHO/Investigating Officer, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 482(2) of the BNSS (erstwhile Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.)
3. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of the order dated 20.05.2025 passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined and cooperated with the investigation.
4. Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Kuldeep Singh



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states that the petitioner has joined the investigation and is not required for custodial interrogation.

5. In view of the statement made by learned State counsel, the petition is allowed and the interim order dated 20.05.2025 is **made absolute**. The petitioner shall continue to join investigation, as and when called by the Investigating Officer and shall also abide by the conditions as provided under Section 482(2) of the BNSS.

6. Pending application(s), if any, shall also stand disposed of.
