Present petition under Section 482 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 (for short, '*the B.N.S.S.*') has been filed for grant of pre-arrest bail to the petitioner in FIR No.0035 dated 12.02.2025, under Sections 305 and 332(c) of Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023, registered at Police Station City South Moga, District Moga.

2. Allegations are that petitioner has committed theft of Rs.2,25,000/- from the money transfer shop of *de facto* complainant.

3. This Court has carefully watched the CCTV recording produced by *de facto* complainant and, *prima facie*, it appears that present petitioner, has committed the alleged crime.

4. In view of the above, his custodial interrogation would be very much necessary to find out the truth.



5. Consequently, there is no option except to dismiss the petition.

6. Ordered accordingly.

7. It is clarified that above observations be not construed as an expression of opinion on merits of the case in any manner.
