1. The present petition has been filed under Section 528 of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 seeking issuance of an appropriate order or direction to respondents No.2 & 3 to conduct fair and impartial investigation by constituting Special Investigation Team in case arising out of FIR No.108 dated 22.10.2024, under Sections 221, 351(3), 121, 296 of Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023 and Section 4 of Punjab Protection of Medicare Service Persons and Medicare Service Institutions (Prevention of Violence and Damage to Property) Bill/Act at Police Station Division No.4, District Police Commissionerate.

2. At the very outset, learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner has recently filed a representation on 02.02.2025 before the Commissioner of Police, Jalandhar District Jalandhar (Annexure P-4) raising his grievances as mentioned in the present petition but the same has not yet been considered and no action has been taken



thereon. He further submitted that at this stage, the petitioner would be satisfied if appropriate directions are issued to respondent No.2-Director General of Police, Punjab, Punjab Police Head Quarter, Sector-9, Chandigarh to decide the aforesaid representation filed by the petitioners and take necessary action thereon.

- 3. Notice of motion.
- 4. Ms. Ruchika Sabherwal, Sr. DAG, Punjab who is present in Court, has accepted the notice on behalf of the respondents-State and submits that the needful will be done in due course. Let a complete set of the paperbook be supplied to her during the course of the day.
- 5. In view of the limited prayer made by the petitioner, without commenting anything on the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of at this stage with a direction to respondent No. 2 to decide the aforesaid representation dated 02.02.2025 (Annexure P-4) of the petitioner within a period of 01 month , by passing a speaking order in accordance with law.
