1. Present civil revision has been filed under Article 227 of the Constitution of India for quashing of order dated 18.03.2025 (Annexure P-12) whereby the warrant of possession has been issued by the Executing Court.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner be permitted to withdraw the present revision petition with liberty to seek alternative remedy in accordance with law.

3. Dismissed as withdrawn, with the aforesaid liberty.

4. It is made clear that this Court has not opined on the maintainability or otherwise on the merits of any such remedy which the petitioner proposes to initiate and in case any such remedy is undertaken, the same would be considered by the concerned Court independently, in accordance with law.
