This petition has been filed for quashing/setting aside the impugned order dated 21.03.2025 passed by learned trial Court, Faridkot whereby the application made by the petitioner for grant of permission to go Abroad has been dismissed with a further prayer for grant of permission to the petitioner for a period of 06 months to go abroad as he is permanent resident of Italy and his medical checkup appointment has been fixed for 07.05.2025 at Italy.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is seeking permission to go abroad for his treatment. The petitioner is permanent resident of Italy and he along with his family is residing over

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there since the year 2007. He further submits that the petitioner will return back to India within two months to attend the court proceedings as the date fixed in the trial Court is 22.07.2025.

3. Learned counsel for the complainant submits that he has no objection if the permission is granted to the petitioner for his treatment in Italy.

4. I have heard the submissions made by learned counsel for the petitioner.

5. Keeping in view the above submissions of the learned counsels for the parties and the fact that the counsel for the respondent has no objection if the petitioner is permitted to go Italy for his treatment, this petition is allowed. The petitioner is permitted to go abroad with the condition that he will return to India before 22.07.2025 the date fixed in the trial Court subject to his furnishing heavy surety to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate/Chief Judicial Magistrate concerned.
