1. The petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 528 of BNSS, 2023, read with Article 226 of the Constitution of India, for issuance of directions to the official respondents to ensure fair investigation in case FIR No.144 dated 04.12.2021, registered under Sections 420, 506, 120-B IPC, at Police Station Jhabal, District Tarn Taran.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that though the FIR has been registered on the complaint of the petitioner, but the investigating agencies are intentionally not proceeding further with the investigation as it is not making any headway.
3. Notice of motion to the official respondents only at this stage.
4. On asking of the Court, Mr. Tarun Aggarwal, Addl. A.G., Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State and submits, on instructions from Inspector Paramjit Singh, that the investigation is at the final stage and the same would be completed within a period of two weeks from today.
