Present second petition has been filed under Section 439 of the Code of the Criminal Procedure, 1973 for grant of bail pending trial to petitioner in FIR No. 170 dated 10.07.2020, under Sections 120B, 201, 302 read with Section 34 of Indian Penal Code, 1860 (for short ‘IPC’) (Sections 201, 420, 467, 468, 471 IPC added subsequently and Sections 279 & 304-A IPC deleted lateron), registered at Police Station Pinjore, District Panchkula.
