1. The present petition has been for quashing of FIR No.45 dated 05.05.2020 registered under Sections 323, 325, 341, 506, 148 and 149 of IPC (charges framed under Sections 323, 325, 341, 506, 148 and 149 of IPC), at Police Station Mullanpur, District SAS Nagar and all the subsequent proceedings arising therefrom, on the basis of compromise dated 28.02.2025 (Annexure P-2).

2. This Court vide order dated 02.04.2025 had directed the parties to appear before the trial Court to get their statements recorded and the learned Magistrate was directed to send its report qua the genuineness of the compromise.

3. Pursuant to the aforesaid order, parties have appeared before the learned Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Kharar and got their statements recorded.

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On the basis of the statements so recorded, learned Magistrate has submitted a copy of report dated 13.05.2025 to the effect that the compromise has been effected between the parties voluntarily and without any coercion or undue influence.

4. Power of Attorney filed on behalf of respondents No.2 and 3 is taken on record. He as well as learned State counsel have not disputed the factum of compromise between the parties.

5. In view of the above, no useful purpose would be served to continue with the proceedings before the trial Court in the instant FIR.

6. Following the principles laid down by the Full Bench judgment of this Court in *Kulwinder Singh and others Versus State of Punjab and another 2007 (3) RCR (Criminal) 1052* and approved by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in *Gian Singh Versus State of Punjab and others (2012) 10 SCC 303*, this petition is allowed and FIR No.45 dated 05.05.2020 registered under Sections 323, 325, 341, 506, 148 and 149 of IPC (charges framed under Sections 323, 325, 341, 506, 148 and 149 of IPC), at Police Station Mullanpur, District SAS Nagar and all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom on the basis of compromise dated 28.02.2025 (Annexure P-2) are quashed qua the petitioners.
