Learned counsel representing the State of Punjab has produced a copy of the order dated 24.04.2025, which was passed in compliance of the directions issued in CWP No.2182 of 2018 and other connected cases on 28.10.2024. As per the said speaking order, the benefit of Assured Career Progression Scheme has been decided to be extended to the petitioners subject to fulfillment of conditions as prescribed by the Government from time to time and also subject to final outcome of the LPA intended to be filed by the Department against the order under reference.
