1. The petitioners have filed the instant petition under Section 528 of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 seeking quashing of FIR No.01 dated 11.06.2018 registered under Sections 306 & 34 of Indian Penal Code, 1860 at Police Station Handesra, District S.A.S. Nagar and all other consequential proceedings arising therefrom on the basis of compromise dated 17.05.2023 arrived at between the parties.

2. In the earlier petition bearing CRM-M No.28929 of 2024 filed by the petitioners seeking the same relief, the following order was passed on 27.02.2025 :-

“1. The present petition has been filed by the petitioners under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for quashing of FIR No.1 dated 11.06.2018 registered under Sections 306/34 IPC, at Police Station Handesra, District SAS Nagar, Punjab (Annexure P-1) and all other subsequent proceedings arising therefrom on the basis of compromise dated 17.05.2023 (Annexure P-2) executed between the parties.



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- 2. *Learned counsel for the petitioners wishes to withdraw the present petition with liberty to avail other legal remedies in accordance with law.*
- 3. *Dismissed as withdrawn with the aforesaid liberty.”*
