This application has been filed for placing on record the copy of the affidavit of respondent No.2 as Annexure R-2/1 dated 03.04.2025.

Allowed as prayed for and the copy of the affidavit of respondent No.2 as Annexure R-2/1 dated 03.04.2025 has been taken on record.

Main case:

The present petition has been filed under Section 528 of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 (for short-‘BNSS’) for quashing of FIR No.282 dated 29.06.2024 under Sections 420/120-B/467/468/471 of IPC and Section 12 of Passport Act registered at Police Station Palam Vihar, District Gurugram and all the subsequent proceedings arising therefrom, on the basis of compromise as Annexure- P-2.

2. Notice of motion.

3. Ms. Ankita Ahuja, AAG, Haryana accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State. Learned State counsel states that no other FIR has been registered against the petitioners and they have no known criminal antecedents.



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4. Mr. C.S.Jattana, Advocate appears and accepts notice on behalf of respondent No.2 in the Court today and the same is taken on record. He confirms the factum of the compromise having been effected between the parties and states that respondent No. 2 has no objection to the quashing of the FIR in question.

5. In that view of the matter, even if this case is taken to its logical conclusion, it would only be an exercise in futility as the parties have already settled their differences. Therefore, no purpose would be served in wasting the time and resources of the State in pursuing this case to its pre-ordained end. It would, therefore, be better to give a quietus to the issue at this stage.

6. Accordingly, the petition is allowed and No.282 dated 29.06.2024 under Sections 420/120-B/467/468/471 of IPC and Section 12 of Passport Act registered at Police Station Palam Vihar, District Gurugram and all the subsequent proceedings arising therefrom, on the basis of compromise as Annexure- P-2 shall stand quashed qua the petitioners.

7. Pending applications, if any, shall also be disposed of.
